## A brief overview of the school, Sri Prabhu Greenville Children Academy

Sri Prabhu Greenville Children Academy is a CBSE-affiliated, co-educational institution located in Bahabalpur, Bhagwanpur, Haridwar, Uttarakhand, established in 2011 by Mr. Dhoom Singh.

### Key highlights:-

- **Beyond Academics:** Sri Prabhu Greenville Children Academy emphasizes a healthy involvement in inter-school competitions, encouraging students to showcase their talents and benchmark their performance. This includes a House System, Clubs, Sports, and Trips and Tours.
- **Talent Attraction:** The school is committed to attracting the best talent (students, teachers, and facilitators) without discrimination based on race, religion, caste, or social status.
- **CBSE Affiliation (3530468):** The school is affiliated with the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), New Delhi, and follows its rules governing promotions.
- **Infrastructure:** It has a campus area of 2.02626 acres (8199.983249064 sq. mtrs) with a built-up area of 1533.32 sq. mtrs and a playground area of 4500 sq. mtrs. The school also has multipurpose rooms, music rooms, and health and medical check-up facilities.
- **Library Facilities:** The library is 1200 sq. ft in size and houses a total of 2345 books, 50 periodicals, 350 reference books, 15 magazines, and 6 dailies.
- **Admission Information:** The school session runs from April to March. Admissions are normally done from Nursery to Class 1 with specific age
